

Justice Circle

A justice circle should have:

- Willing participation of the offender (accused)
- A teacher, administrator, or counselor to act as the facilitator (leader). This person will organize the agenda of the justice circle, lead the discussion, and summarize what has been decided.
- Peers of the student who committed the offence, some chosen for their guidance qualities and others who are close to the student.
- Person who the offence was committed against. (the victim)
- Volunteers who are interested in helping or who may have some knowledge of the offence.
- Confidentiality
