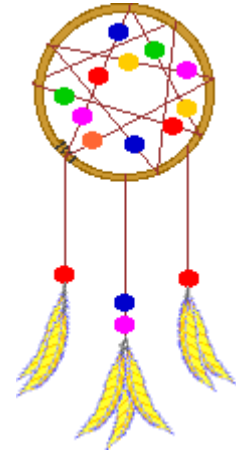






Making a Dream Catcher



For each dream catcher you will need:

- a bendable twig about 1 foot long
- a few inches of thin wire
- some twine
- beads with large holes
- a few feathers

|  <p>Use thin wire to tie the ends of a twig together to make a hoop.</p> | <p>Have an adult make a hoop from a twig. To do this, wrap a short length of thin wire around the overlapping ends.</p> |
|  <p></p> | <p>Cut a couple metres of twine. Tie one end of the twine to the twig hoop. String a few beads onto the twine and push the beads toward the tied end. Wrap the twine around the other side of the hoop.</p> |
|  <p></p> | <p>String a few more beads on the twine and then wrap the twine around the far side of the hoop. Repeat until you have an interesting webbing design.</p> |
|  <p></p> | <p>Tie a short length of twine on the hoop. String a bead or two on it and then tie a feather onto the end. Repeat this a few times (2 or 3 hanging feather strings look nice). Hang the dream catcher near your bed!</p> |
